

Functionality and Requirements

ODBC stands for Open Database Connectivity and is a connection which is used to allow a user to get information from a system e.g. VIP and into an external source e.g. Excel

- You can create your own reports in Excel using the VIP ODBC Tables
- The tables consists of fields found in the VIP System
- Within the report, once the data has been extracted, the user can:
 - Manipulate the information extracted
 - Add formulas and Charts
 - Create pivot tables and charts
- ODBC is also used in:
 - SMART Reporting
 - Sage Intelligence Reporting

System Requirements for ODBC, SMART and Sage Intelligence

- VIP must be mapped to a drive letter under computer e.g. V:\ and not to a server name e.g. \\servername
- Local admin rights on the C:\ or profile logging in on the terminal server and the VIP directory
- If users log in via a terminal connection, the profile will need the requirements listed
- Operating System: Windows 7, 8 and 10 (32 or 64-bit)
- Reporting tool: Minimum Office 2007 (for SMART Office 2010), Professional – activated and installed with all features and add-ins running from this computer (32-bit), only Sage Intelligence does work on 64-bit office packages
- User will need full local administrative rights (read/write/modify) on both the PC and the VIP directory
- Anti-Virus, Firewalls and Windows Defender must **exclude** the VIP directory as this can remove and restrict access to files.
- .NET Frameworks:
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 - 2 Service Pack 2
 - 3 Service Pack 2
 - 3.5 Service Pack 1
 - 4 Full client
 - 4.5.1
