National Minimum Wage Act

The National Minimum Wage Act, 2018 has commenced on 1 January 2019. Read the government gazette here.

OID Earnings Threshold

The Minister of Labour published Government Gazette No. 42092, increasing the OID earnings threshold to R458 520 per annum, with effect from 1 March 2019 (2019/2020 year of assessment). Find the government gazette here.
